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BASIC PROVISIONS



NATIONAL REGULATION:

Law on foreign trade in weapons, military equipment and dual-use goods (2005), accompanied with by-laws:

- National Control List of weapons and military equipment and related technologies,
- List of dual-use goods including software and technologies that may be used for both civilian and military purposes,
- Criterion for issuing license for foreign trade with controlled goods,
- Regulation for conducting register of company registered for foreign trade,
- Regulations for issuing documentation necessary for foreign trade

EXPORT CONTROL AGREEMENTS:

- Wassenaar Arrangement – WA,
- Nuclear Suppliers Group – NSG,
- The Australia Group-AG,
- Missile Technology Control Regime – MTCR

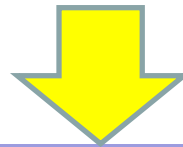

REGISTER FOR FOREIGN TRADE IN CONTROLLED GOODS



In order to register for foreign trade in controlled goods, a company should submit **an application** to the **MINISTRY OF FOREIGN AND INTERNAL TRADE AND TELECOMMUNICATIONS**.



A license for foreign trade of controlled goods is a written document of the **Ministry of Foreign and Internal Trade and Telecommunications**, which allows the company to perform the single foreign trade of known quantity and type of controlled goods under the conditions agreed upon a contract between person and foreign trade partner for the purpose of granting export license of controlled goods.



PROCESS OF ISSUING LICENSE FOR FOREIGN TRADE

1. License application for foreign trade in controlled goods.
2. The applicant is also required to submit an original **END USER CERTIFICATE**.
3. Certificate of origin in case of imports.
4. Quantity, type, chemical and other characteristics of controlled goods.
5. Contract between domestic and foreign trade partner.
6. Authorization from the owner of the goods given to the exporter – importer.



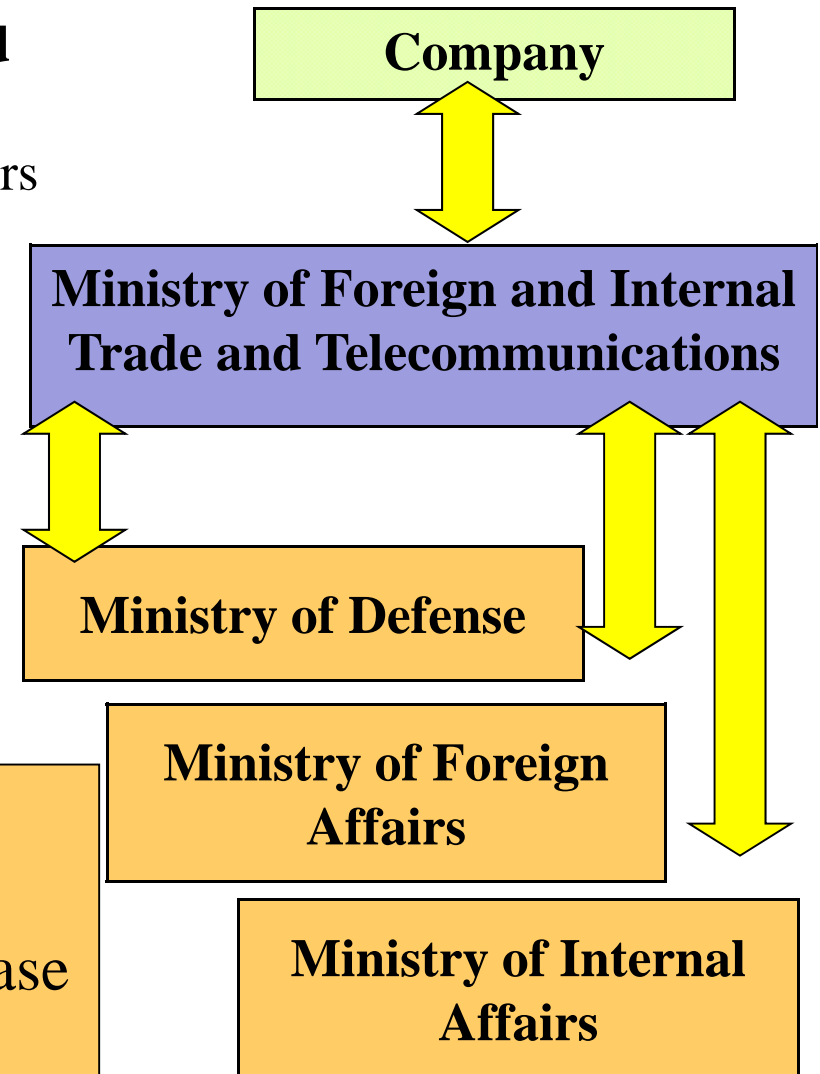
ISSUING LICENSE PROCEDURE – DECISION MAKING PROCESS

The Ministry of Foreign and Internal Trade and Telecommunications shall seek consent from the ministries responsible for foreign and internal affairs and defense of Republic of Serbia.

The aforementioned Ministry will decide on a license application within 30 days of the receipt thereof.

The license validity is limited to **one-year period.**

Sector for Material Resources is responsible for processing and issuing consent on behalf of MoD and EUC in case of import for Serbian Armed Forces.





TRANSPORT AND TRANSIT OF WEAPONS AND MILITARY EQUIPMENT

Continental and waterway transit (with or without transshipment) of weapons and military equipment shall be performed in the prescribed manner upon approval given by the **ministries responsible for internal affairs** of the Republic of Serbia and with consent of the ministries responsible for foreign affairs and defense of Serbia.

ON THE BEHALF OF MoD, OPERATIONAL CENTER OF SAF IS IN CHARGE OF GIVING CONSENT FOR TRANSIT.

Air transit of weapons and military equipment is performed in the prescribed manner upon approval by the **authority of Serbia responsible for Civil Aviation**, and with consent of the ministries responsible for foreign affairs and defense of Serbia.

Continental and waterway transport and transit of weapons and military equipment on the territory of Serbia is to be conducted with an armed escort.



CURRENT WORK ON NEW REGULATION

Draft Law for export and import of armaments and military equipment

Draft Law for export and import of dual-use goods

New solutions in draft version of Law:

- Registration of broker and persons in charge for export/import,
- Introduction of Security Information Agency in decision making process,
- Exception from procedure in case of multinational operation, exercise, emergency cases... as part of Serbia obligation according to multinational agreements.

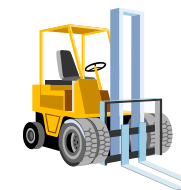

Annex of notification document contains following:

Potential carriers, Routes, Information on waste generator, Description of waste, Notification of contract between exporter and importer of waste, Insurance policy, List of the competent authorities of exporter, importer and transit.

16 03 off-specified batches and unused products,
16 03 03 inorganic wastes containing dangerous substances

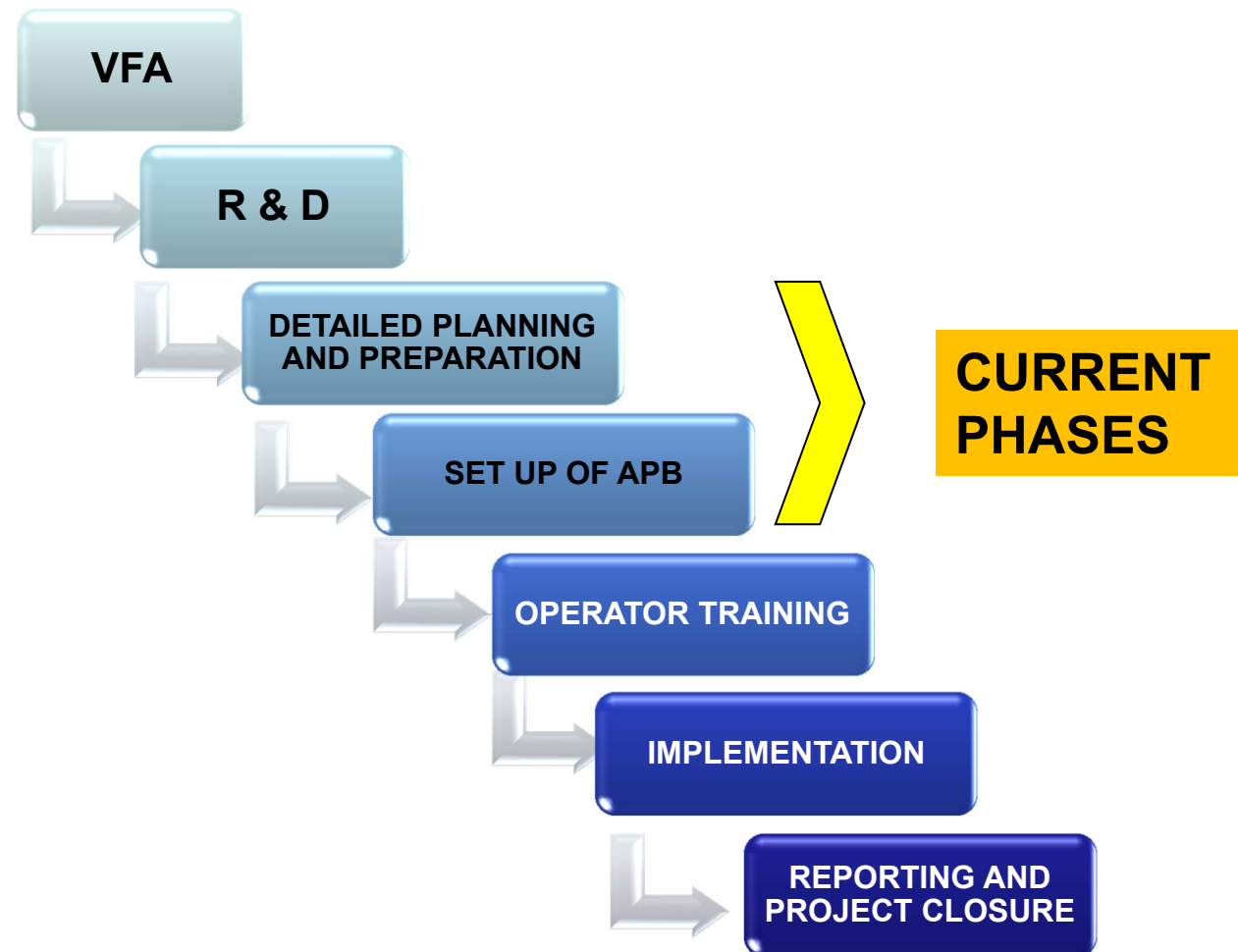

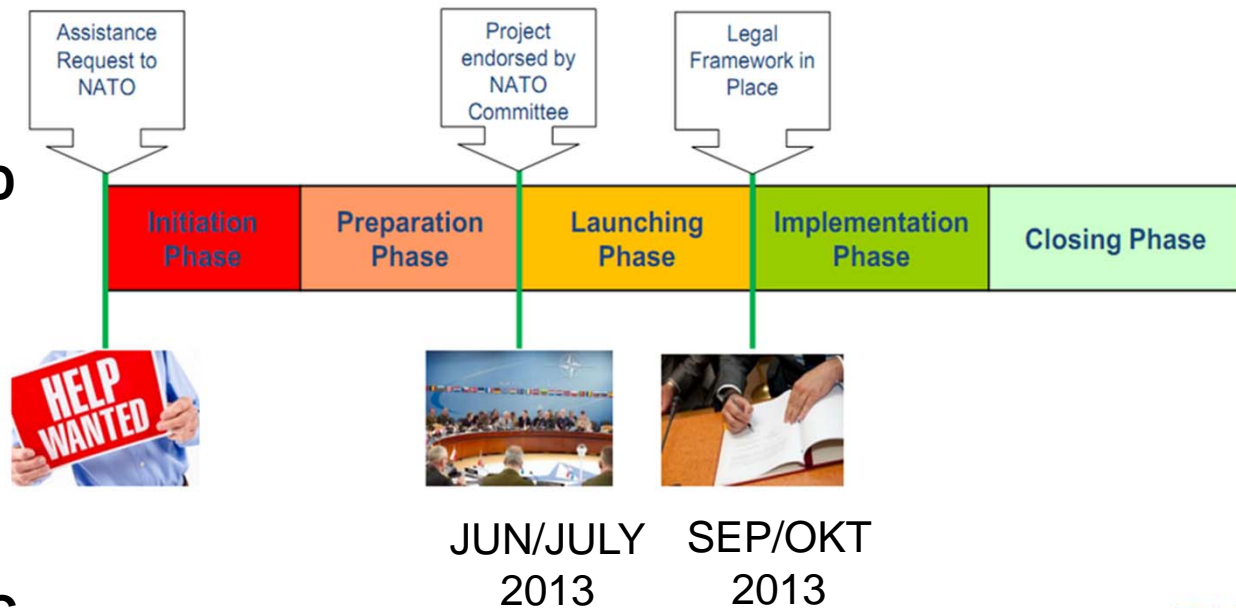
